



Library Cards

Library cards are available to all residents of Stanly County, ages 5 and up, free of charge. Positive photo identification (preferably valid NC driver's license or special ID) and proof of current address is required. A bill with the patron name and current address is acceptable for proof of address in addition to the photo ID. Library privileges are available to non-residents for a yearly fee, set by the County Commissioners.

Library cards are available to all teachers who are employed at a school in Stanly County free of charge. Positive identification (such as a school ID or paycheck stub), along with a positive photo ID, and proof of current address is required for verification. These cards are for school use only.

Library cards are available to college students who are living on campus in Stanly County free of charge. Positive photo identification (preferably school ID) and proof of a residential address and permanent address are required.

You may register for a library card at any Stanly County Library location.

Institutional Library Cards
